### **Reducing Methane**

First movers in implementing methane emission reduction technologies

# **External Recognition**



For the second year in a row, we received the highest score in the annual *Disclosing the Facts* report, which assesses companies in our industry on information disclosure and responsible business practices.



Our air emissions reporting was cited as an example of good Reporting in Practice in Setting the Bar: Implementing the TCFD Recommendations for Oil and Gas Methane Disclosure, an October 2018 report by Ceres, the Environmental Defense Fund and PRI.



We entered into our first <u>agreement</u> to sell certified environmentally friendly "SWN Gas" from wells certified through the Independent Energy Standards Corporation's TrustWell™ Responsible Gas Ratings program.
